90 pts “Light bright yellow. Ripe melon, tangerine and jasmine on the nose and in the mouth; a touch of honey builds in the glass. Silky and seamless in the mouth, offering juicy honeydew and citrus fruit flavors and a bitter orange zest flourish that adds back-end cut. Smoothly blends richness and vivacity and closes with bright, tangy lift and very good, floral persistence.”
